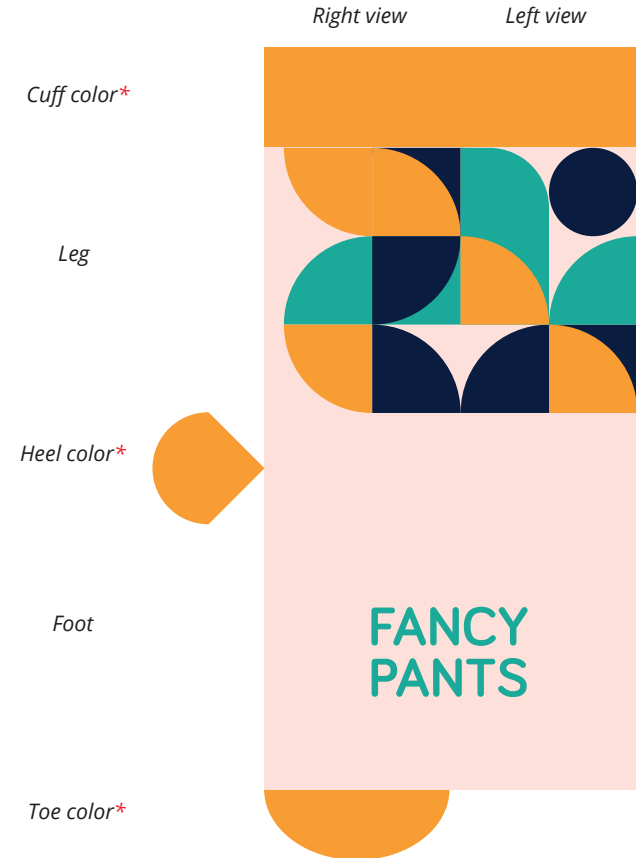


Custom Socks with a Logo

This file provides a rough idea of how a design is affected by the weaving process of a custom-made sock. A weaving process, not printing, customize our socks. Each sock is built from scratch using colored yarn instead of printing on a complete sock.

Weaving cannot reproduce the exact intricate detail that a computer or a printer could without losing a significant amount of the finest detail. Patterns will change, and detailed design will become simplified, similar to a pixelated graphic.

The easiest way to get into the order process is to send your graphics, logos, and color requests to our Graphic Design team and leave the work to us. If you are confident enough to try it, below is an example of how different sock parts are composed. Note that the weaving process will significantly simplify the design of a finished sock.



Important! Each pair of socks is identical by default. For a custom left and right sock, an additional charge is added. This is only a preview of an individual sock design from each side.

*The parts that stretch the most (cuff, heel, toe) must be made using a single-color design. No logos or graphical elements are added.
